
Two Cultures: Mosaic Rights & Column Rights





Mosaic rights → high social equity, high biodiversity;
Column rights → successful markets

Magodes, Molo, Uganda


Protected riparian land

- Communal clan ownership
- No unethical behaviour allowed
- Knowledgeable elders can collect medicinal plants

(& replant at homestead)

- Access points for animals
- Protects & cleans water
- 'Savings Bank' of genetic reserves




- Communal clan ownership

(roofs, mats, brooms)










COLLISIONS & COMPLICATIONS


